Research Profile

My research examines the formation, dissemination, and mobilisation of extremist ideologies through a multidisciplinary and multi-method framework integrating history, political science, sociolinguistics, and international relations. It focuses on political radicalism, terrorism, and political violence in comparative and transnational perspective, analysing the interactions between extremist movements, state and non-state actors, and security and intelligence institutions. By situating radicalisation within broader historical and geopolitical contexts, the research contributes to the study of security governance and extremist mobilisation. The research is complemented by experience in coordinating large-scale, transnational research teams, including editorial coordination of the *Routledge Handbook of Italian Fascism and Neofascism*.
